Alexander, Ellie *Without a Brew* – cozy mystery- (Book 4 in the Sloan Krause Series) Amateur sleuth Sloan Krause delves into a murderous winter wonderland in another delightful mystery.

Amis, Martin *Inside Story* - This extraordinary novel gives the reader the heart-to-heart testimony of one of our finest writers – a wonder of literary invention and a boisterous modern classic.

Andrews, Donna *The Gift of the Magpie* – cozy mystery – (Book 28 in the Meg Langslow Series) Another wonderfully merry and funny book.

Baker, A. Deborah *Over the Woodward Wall* –horror- Writing as A. Deborah Baker, award winning author Seanan McGuire introduces a world of talking trees, sarcastic owls, damerous mermaids, and captivating queens.

Banville, John *Snow*-mystery- (Book 1 in the St. John Strafford Series) The sinister and unnerving Snow has all the trimmings of a classic country house mystery; a body in the library, a closed circle of suspects, and foul weather.

Bear, Elizabeth *Machine* –Science Fiction- (Book 2 in the White Space Series) A fascinating and complete universe that blends high-tech gadgetry with Old World adventure and political collusion.

Beatty, Pete *Cuyahoga* -Tragedy and farce jumble together in a riotously original voice. Evoking the Greek classics and the Bible alongside nods to Looney Tunes, Charles Portis, and Flannery O'Connor, Pete Beatty has written a rollicking revisionist (mid)Western with universal themes of family and fate—an old, weird America that feels brand new.

Berry, Tamara *Curses Are for Cads*-cozy mystery – (Book 3 in the Eleanor Wilde Mystery Series) Just as fake medium Eleanor Wilde begins falling for Nicholas Hartford III and his endearing family, she's summoned to a remote Scottish castle where an unusual assignment to locate a haunted trove of treasure threatens Eleanor's budding romance, her livelihood, and her life!

Boggs, Johnny D. *A Thousand Texas Longhorns* –western- A powerful, trailblazing adventure inspired by the harrowing true story of the 1866 cattle drive from Texas to Montana.

Brabazon, James *All Fall Down* – (Book 2 in the Max McLean Series) British intelligence operative and hardened assassin Max McLean must discover who's killing the members of his team.

Bradford, Barbara Taylor *In the Lion's Den* - (Book 2 in the House of the Falconer Series) Gripping, dramatic and bringing the England of Queen Victoria and the British Empire vividly to life, *In the Lion's Den* is a sweeping historical epic.

Cameron, W. Bruce *A Dog's Perfect Christmas* A poignant, uplifting Yuletide tale of family members, both two-legged and four-legged, and the ties that bind even when modern life seems determined to pull them apart.

Camilleri, Andrea *The Sicilian Method* – mystery- (Book 26 in the Inspector Montalbano Series) Montalbano finds his answers to a murder in a theatrical play.

Carr, Robyn *Return to Virgin River*-romance- (A Book in the Virgin River Series) Don't miss the eagerly anticipated new novel set in the beloved fictional town of Virgin River, where strangers become friends and everyone is welcome. It's the perfect escape read you've been waiting for.

Child, Lee *The Sentinel*- (Book 25 in the Jack Reacher Series) Jack Reacher gets off a bus in Nashville, Tennessee, in a quest for food, lodging and some good country music. But when he encounters a band of musicians who have been cheated by an unscrupulous bar owner, he steps in to help

Connealy, Mary *Her Secret Song*- (Book 3 in the Brides of Hope Mountain Series) To overcome her fears of the outside world, Ursula Nordegren treks down Hope Mountain where she discovers a badly wounded man. Wax Mosby is remorseful over driving out the Wardens, but when he's hurt, the last person he expect to rescue him is a beautiful woman related to them. As they weigh the cost of living new lives, an unlikely bond forms between them.

Connolly, John *The Dirty South* – mystery- (Book 18 in the Charlie Parker Series) In an Arkansas jail cell sits a former NYPD detective, stricken by grief. He is mourning the death of his wife and child, and searching in vain for their killer. Obsessed with avenging his lost family, his life is about to take a shocking turn. Witness the becoming of Charlie Parker

Cossette, Connilyn *To Dwell Among Cedars* – (Book 1 in the Covenant House Series) Determined to return the Ark of the Covenant to Shiloh, Levite musician Ronen never expected that Eliora, the Philistine girl he rescued years ago, would be part of the family he's tasked to deceive. As his attempts to charm her lead them in unexpected directions, they question their loyalties when their beliefs about the Ark and themselves are shaken

Cussler, Clive *Marauder* – (Book 15 in the Oregon Files Series) Juan Cabrillo and the crew of the Oregon are on the case again, with another high-stakes high seas mission packed with page-turning intrigue and exhilarating suspense.

Danforth, Emily M. *Plain Bad Heroines* - A devilishly haunting, modern masterwork of metafiction that manages to combine the ghostly sensibility of Sarah Waters with the dark imagination of Marisha Pessl and the sharp humor and incisive social commentary of Curtis Sittenfeld into one laugh-out-loud funny, spellbinding, and wonderfully luxuriant read.

Diop, David *At Night All Blood Is Black*- Peppered with bullets and black magic, this remarkable novel fills in a forgotten chapter in the history of World War I. Blending oral storytelling traditions with the gritty, day-to-day, journalistic horror of life in the trenches. A dazzling tale of a man's descent into madness.

Doctorow, Cory *Attack Surface* – science fiction - Returning to the world of Little Brother and Homeland, Attack Surface takes us five minutes into the future, to a world where everything is connected and everyone is vulnerable.

Ellicott, Jessica *Murder Comes to Call* –mystery- (Book 4 in the Beryl and Edwina Mystery Series) The lean years following World War I can lead to desperate acts, even in the quiet English village of Walmsley Parva. When a series of burglaries seems to culminate in murder, brash American Beryl Helliwell and proper, buttoned up Brit Edwina Davenport (and her dog, Crumpet) are eager to solve the case.

Elliott, Lauren *A Page Marked for Murder*-cozy mystery- (Book 5 in the Beyond the Page Bookstore Mystery Series) A murder and a missing book have Addie Greyborne running around her Massachusetts town trying to read the clues.

Erickson, Alex *Death by French Roast* –cozy mystery – (Book 8 in the Bookstore Café Mystery Series) Krissy Hancock runs a bookstore-café in Pine Hills, Ohio, but she'll be setting up shop as a sleuth when she discovers a long-unsolved murder

Flagg, Fannie *The Wonder Boy of Whistle Stop* - (Book 2 in the Whistle Stop Series) Buddy Threadgoode decides to take one last trip, just to see what has become of his beloved Whistle Stop. In so doing, he discovers new friends, as well as surprises about Idgie's life, about Ninny Threadgoode and about the town itself.

Franklin, Ariana *Death and the Maiden*-mystery- (Book 5 in the Mistress of the Art of Death Series) The final installment in this series has Adelia's daughter Allie off to solve a mystery on her own.

Frear, Caz *Shed No Tears* – mystery – (Book 3 in the Cat Kinsella Series) Four victims. Killer caught. Case closed . . . or is it?

French, Nicci *House of Correction*-mystery- Tabitha is accused of murder. She is in prison awaiting trial. There is a strong case against her, and she can't remember what happened on December 21st. She is alone, frightened and confused. But somehow, from the confines of her cell, she needs to prove everyone wrong.

French, Tana *The Searcher*-mystery- A masterful tale of breath-taking beauty and suspense, asking what we sacrifice in our search for truth and justice, and the dangers of finding what we seek.

Gaynor, Hazel *When We Were Young & Brave*- Inspired by true events surrounding the Japanese Army's internment of teachers and children from a British missionary school. It is an unforgettable novel about impossible choices and unimaginable hardship, and the life-changing bonds formed between a young girl and her teacher in a remote corner of a terrible war.

Goldenbaum, Sally *A Crime of a Different Stripe*-cozy mystery – (Book 4 in the Seaside Knitters Society Series) As sleepy Sea Harbor, Massachusetts settles into the glow of autumn, a baby-on-the-way has the Seaside Knitters feeling warm and fuzzy. Only, these crafty ladies can't get too cozy when sweater weather delivers an unexpected arrival—murder!

Goodman, Joanna *The Forgotten Daughter*- A compulsively readable story of love and friendship, following the lives of two women reckoning with their pasts and the choices that will define their futures.

Grisham, John *A Time for Mercy* –mystery- (Book 3 in the Jake Brigance Series) Jake Brigance is back. This time he's at the epicenter of a sensational murder trial that bitterly divides the citizens of Clanton, Mississippi.

Haines, Carolyn *A Garland of Bones*-cozy mystery- (Book 22 in the Sarah Booth Delaney Series) Spunky southern private investigator Sarah Booth Delaney tackles a string of strange accidents while celebrating the holiday season.

Hamilton, Peter F. *The Saints of Salvation*-science fiction- (Book 3 in the Salvation Sequence Series) Humanity welcomed the Olyx and their utopian technology. But mankind was tricked. Now these visitors are extracting a terrible price.

Hannon, Irene *Point of Danger*- (Book 1 in the Triple Threat Series) Radio talk show host Eve Reilly is used to backlash from her pot-stirring on-air commentary and interviews, but now it seems a disgruntled listener is resorting to more than angry words to express their displeasure. Can Detective Brent Lange help when a suspicious package arrives on her doorstep?

Hausmann, Romy *Dear Child* –mystery- A windowless shack in the woods. A dash to safety, but when a woman finally escapes her captor, the end of the story is only the beginning of her nightmare.

Henderson, Alice *A Solitude of Wolverines*-mystery- (Book 1 in the Alex Carter Series) A wildlife biologist who courts trouble as she saves endangered species, and a mysterious killer who buries his dead in the land she helps preserve mark this fast-paced, action-driven tale of suspense.

Herbert, Brian *The Duke of Caladan*-science fiction- (A Book in the Dune Series) A prequel to Dune this tells the tale of Duke Leto Atreides and his partner Jessica.

Hilderbrand, Elin *Troubles in Paradise*-romance- (Book 3 in the Paradise Series) After uprooting her life in the States, Irene Steele has just settled in at the villa on St. John where her husband Russ had been living a double life. But a visit from the FBI shakes her foundations, and Irene once again learns just how little she knew about the man she loved.

Hoffman, Alice *Magic Lessons* – (A Book in the Practical Magic Series) Where does the story of the Owens bloodline begin? With Maria Owens, in the 1600s, when she's abandoned in a snowy field in rural England as a baby.

Hunt, Angela Elwell *The Shepherd's Wife*- (Book 2 in the Jerusalem Road Series) When her husband is thrown into debtor's prison Pheodora, sister of Yeshua of Nazareth, pins her hopes on the birth of two spotless goats to sell for the

upcoming Yom Kippur sacrifice so that she can provide for her daughters and survive. Calling on her wits, her family, and her God, can she trust that He will hear and help a lowly shepherd's wife?

Hunter, Denise *Autumn Skies*- (Book 3 in the Bluebell Inn Series) From the bestselling author of *The Convenient Groom* and *A December Bride* (now beloved Hallmark Original movies) comes the third and final novel in the Bluebell Inn series!

Jackson, Lisa *You Betrayed Me* – romance- (Book 4 in the San Francisco Series) The Cahill family are famous for two things: their wealth, and the scandals that surround them.

Jewell, Lisa *Invisible Girl*-mystery- A taut and white-knuckled thriller following a group of people whose lives shockingly intersect when a young woman disappears.

Kingsbury, Karen *Truly, Madly, Deeply* – (A Book in the Baxters Series) In love for the first time, a son's decisions about the future divides his family in this fearless and thought-provoking novel

Kinsella, Sophie *Love Your Life*-romance- Ava and Matt love each other, they just can't love each other's lives. Can they reconcile their differences to find one life together?

Koontz, Dean R. *Elsewhere*-mystery-The fate of the world is in the hands of a father and daughter in an epic novel of wonder and terror.

Ladd, Sarah E. *The Light at Wyndcliff*- (Book 3 in the Cornwall Series) Set in 1820s Cornwall, this Regency romance evokes the captivating worlds and delicious dramas of Jane Austen, Daphne DuMaurier, and Winston Graham.

Lauren, Christina *In a Holiday* –romance- Love Actually meets Groundhog Day in this quintessential holiday romance.

Leavitt, David *Shelter in Place* -David Leavitt returns with his signature "coolly elegant prose" to deliver a comedy of manners for the Trump era.

Mackintosh, Anneliese *Bright and Dangerous Objects* – science fiction- Commercial deep-sea diver Solvig has a secret. McCall Smith, Alexander *How to Raise an Elephant*-mystery- (Book 21 in the No 1 Ladies Detective Agency Series) They say it takes a village to raise a child, but can Mma Ramotswa and the rest of the No. 1 Ladies' Detective Agency come together to raise a pipsqueak pachyderm? We may find out in this novel. We may not. Who can say?

McDermid, Val *Still Life*-mystery- (Book 6 in the Karen Pirie Series) From internationally bestselling author Val McDermid comes a propulsive new Karen Pirie thriller that delves into a historic missing persons case, fake identities, and art forgery.

McKenna, Lindsay *Silver Creek Fire*-mystery- (Book 1 in the Silver Creek Series) Lindsay McKenna combines pulse-pounding suspense with the romance of a contemporary Western for the first installment in her highly emotional, engrossingly swoon-worthy Silver Creek Fire series.

Miller, Linda Lael *Country Proud*-romance- (Book 2 in the Painted Pony Creek Series) Eli Garrett realizes something is missing in his life and he is hoping that Brynne Bailey is the answer, but is there more to her story than she is letting on?

Molloy, Aimee *Goodnight Beautiful*-mystery- An irresistible psychological thriller featuring a newly married woman whose life is turned upside down when her husband goes missing.

Morgan, Sarah *One More for Christmas* -romance- This Christmas three women will learn that sometimes facing up to a few home truths is all you need to heal your heart

Moss, Tara *The War Widow*-mystery - (Book 1 in the Billie Walker Mystery Series) The war may be officially over, but journalist Billie Walker's search for a missing young immigrant man will plunge her right back into the danger and drama she thought she'd left behind in Europe in this thrilling tale of courage and secrets set in glamorous postwar Sydney.

Noble, Shelley *A Resolution at Midnight*-mystery- (Book 3 in the Lady Dunbridge Mystery Series) Miss Fisher meets Downton Abbey in this critically acclaimed mystery series.

Novak, Brenda *A California Christmas*-romance- (Book 7 in the Silver Springs Series) Both Emery and Dallas had been planning on a quiet, solitary Christmas, but the sparks between them are lighting a fire strong enough to last—possibly forever.

Ochse, Weston *Alien – Infiltrator*-science fiction- Dr. Timothy Hoenikker arrives on Pala Station, a Weyland-Yutani facility testing the effects of Xenomorph bio-materials on living creatures. Peterson, Tracie *Forever by Your Side*- (Book 3 in the Willamette Brides Series) Accompanied by her best friend, Thomas Lowell, Constance Browning returns from studying in the East to catalog the native peoples of Oregon--and to prove that her missionary parents aren't involved in a secret conspiracy to goad the oppressed tribes to war. As tensions rise amid shocking revelations, Constance may also have a revelation of the heart.

Taylor, Patrick *An Irish Country Welcome*-(Book 15 in the Irish Country Series) Welcome back to Ballybucklebo, as vividly brought to life by a master storyteller.

Thayne, RaeAnne *Christmas at Holiday House*-romance- (Book 12 in the Haven Point Series) Underneath the Christmas lights Abby must decide if a Christmas at Holiday House has given her everything she needs for Christmas, and forever.

Thomas, Sherry *Murder on Cold Street*-mystery- (Book 5 in the Lady Sherlock Series) Charlotte Holmes, Lady Sherlock, investigates a puzzling new murder case that implicates Scotland Yard inspector Robert Treadles.

Tope, Rebecca *A Cotswold Christmas Mystery*-cozy mystery- (Book 18 in the Thea Osborne Series) Christmas Day arrives. There are presents, a turkey, and general goodwill, despite Thea's suppressed hankering to be involved in events at the Frowse's house, where a dead man has been discovered

Unger, Lisa *Confessions on the 7:45* - Expertly plotted and reminiscent of the timeless classic *Strangers on a Train*, *Confessions on the 7:45* is a gripping thriller about the delicate facades we create around our lives

VanLiere, Donna *The Christmas Table*-(Book 11 in the Christmas Hope Series) A table built with love filled with recipes from a previous generation fills the holidays with hope and love.

Von Ziegesar, Cecily *Cobble Hill* - A deliciously irresistible novel chronicling a year in the life of four families in an upscale Brooklyn neighborhood as they seek purpose, community, and meaningful relationships until one unforgettable night at a raucous neighborhood party knocks them to their senses.

Walter, Jess *The Cold Millions*- A propulsive, richly entertaining novel about two adventure-seeking brothers, the enemies who threaten them, and the women who reveal to them an unjust world on the brink of upheaval.

Warren, Susan May *The Price of Valor* – (Book 3 in the Global Search and Rescue Series) Former Navy SEAL Hamilton Jones thought that the love of his life was dead. Yates, Maisey *The Last Christmas Cowboy* –romance- (Book 11 in the Gold Valley Series) Rose is determined to start a match between her sister and Logan Heath, but it is Rose that this hunky cowboy is attracted to.

Adams, Michelle -*Little Wishes*-romance- Once a year, Elizabeth Davenport awakens to find a blue crocus and a note beginning, "I Wish..." left on her doorstep by her lost true love, Tom Hale. On what should have been their fiftieth anniversary, the gifts fail to appear.

Alford, Mary -*Covert Amish Christmas*-inspirational-CIA agent Victoria Kauffman is hiding in Amish country from the men who killed her partner. With them closing in on her, the only person she can trust is the widower Aaron Shetler.

Archer, Jeffrey -*Hidden in Plain Sight*-historical mystery-(Book 2 of the William Warwick series) - Reassigned to the drug squad, the newly promoted Detective Sergeant William Warwick is assigned his first case: bring down the Viper, south London's most ruthless drug lord. However an old enemy resurfaces and Warwick must devise a trap to capture both men.

Atkins, Ace -*Robert B. Parker's Someone to Watch over Me*-mystery-(Book 49 in the Spenser series)- Spenser teams up with Mattie Sullivan—a girl he helped over a decade ago—to find the killer of her childhood friend. The duo soon find evidence linking the murdered girl to others victims, as well as to an eccentric billionaire with ties to local businesses and politicians.

Bailey, James -*The Flip Side*-romance- Jobless, homeless, and heartbroken, Josh decides to forgo making his own decisions and leave fate up to the flip of a coin.

Bailey, Jodie- *Fatal Identity*-romantic suspense- At a mountaintop wedding ceremony, deputy U.S. marshal Dana Santiago is nearly abducted. Only the quick actions of Alex Richardson save her. Together the pair must investigate why the kidnappers want Dana so badly.

Beaton, M. C.- *Hot to Trot*-cozy mystery-(Book 13 in the Agatha Raisin mystery series)-After crashing her former lover Charles Fraith's wedding, Agatha Raisin wants to be left alone to nurse her hangover. However, her phone rings and she learns that the new Mrs. Fraith has been murdered. Despite being considered a suspect herself, Agatha takes the case.

Bellefleur, Alexandria -*Written in the Stars*-LGBTQ romance-To save face after a disastrous blind date, Darcy lies to her brother and claims it was GREAT. However, her brother's new business partner just so happens to be Elle—the other half of the date.

Bokal, Jennifer D. -*Agent's Mountain Rescue*-romantic suspense-(Book 2 in the Wyoming Nights series)-Operative Liam Alexander teams up with child psychologist Holly Jacobs to take down a serial killer. Their relationship becomes personal when Liam's daughter is abducted by the killer they're hunting.

Booth, Karen -*All He Wants for Christmas*-romance-(Book 3 in the Sterling Wives series)-Johnathon Sterling dies, ending his brother Andrew Sterling's quest to destroy Sterling Enterprises. Sparks fly when Andrew meets his newly widowed sister-in-law, Miranda.

Brackston, Paula -*The Garden of Promises and Lies*-fantasy-(Book 3 in the Found Things series)-Xanthe is trying to keep her time-traveling adventures a secret, but an old wedding dress and her nemesis, Benedict Fairfax, make secrets difficult.

Brooks, Karen- *The Lady Brewer of London*-historical- In 1405, Anneke Sheldrake's family loses their fortune when her father is swept out to sea. Rather than marry an odious cousin, Anneke turns to her late mother's trade: brewing ale. With unlikely allies and a stellar recipe, Anneke is determined to reclaim her status and livelihood.

Brown, Rita Mae- *Out of Hounds-cozy mystery*-(Book 13 in the Jane Arnold series)-The new neighbors of the Jefferson Hunt Club keep posting notices about noise levels and animal cruelty. Sister Jane tries to keep an open mind, but the situation worsens as someone close to her is defamed.

Bruen, Ken -*A Galway Epiphany-mystery*-(Book 16 in the Jack Taylor series)-After being hit by a truck, Jack Taylor is a coma. The two children that helped him are being hailed as saints, yet they are missing. A fraudulent order of nuns is also looking for the children, and a murdering arsonist is on the loose.

Brunstetter, Jean -*The Blended Quilt-inspirational*-The relationship between Sadie Kuhns and Wymann Kauffman is stagnating. He's jealous of her passion for her quilting and writing, while she's frustrated that he won't commit to a secure profession. Is there any hope for their relationship?

Instead, she finds herself thrust back into the colorful and scandalous world of mysteries she fled to San Francisco to avoid.

Douglas, Claire -*Do Not Disturb*-mystery-It's been seventeen years since Selena tore Kristy's life apart. Now she's here as the inaugural guest of Kristy's new inn. Why has Selena chosen now to reappear and who is she running from?

Duncan, Elizabeth J. -*On Deadly Tides*-cozy mystery-(Book 11 in the Penny Brannigan series)-Penny Brannigan loves her idyllic island retreat. She loves it right to the point where she finds the broken body of a New Zealand journalist that washed up on shore.

Eden, Sarah M -*The Gentleman and the Thief*-historical romance-(Book 3 in the Proper Romance Victorian series)-Hollis is a down on his luck gentleman forced to pen penny dreadfuls to pay his family's bills. Ana is a music teacher by day and a thief of trinkets by night. Together, they'll fight crime.

Evanovich, Janet -*Fortune and Glory*-romantic suspense-(Book 27 in the Stephanie Plum series) - Stephanie and Grandma Mazur are desperate to find Jim Rosolli's lost treasure. But they're in a race against time with the formidable Gabriela Rose and two other enemies from Stephanie's past.

Hopen, David -*The Orchard*-literary-A coming-of-age story set in an opulent Jewish high school, following boys testing their morals and faith.

Horowitz, Anthony -*Moonflower Murders*-mystery-(Book 2 in the Magpie Murder series)-Frustrated at her imperfect island life, Susan Ryeland jumps at the chance to take a case linked to an old book she edited years ago.

Reyes, Dolores -*Eartheater*-literary-A young woman's compulsion to eat earth gives her visions of the missing and the murdered.

Richards, Ramona -*Burying Daisy Doe*-mystery-(Book 1 in the Star Cavanaugh Cold Case series)-Star Cavanaugh is a cold case detective with a tragic past and a drive to keep her history from repeating itself.

Roberts, Nora -*The Awakening*-paranormal romance-(Book 1 in the Dragon Heart Legacy series)-An embittered Breen Kelly is shocked to learn that her mother left her an investment account worth nearly four million dollars. When she

uses the money to travel to Ireland, she begins to see visions of a silver-haired man and dragons, along with a portal that beckons her “home”.

Wiseman, Beth -*A Picture of Love-inspirational*-(Book 1 of the Amish Inn series)-Esther Zook and Lizzie Glick decide to open an Amish B&B. Both women are widowed, but content, and wish to help others by playing matchmaker.

Yates, Maisey -*Claiming the Rancher's Heir-romance*-(Book 2 in the Gold Valley Vineyards series)-Wren Maxfield loathes Cooper Creed, but one night their mutual dislike flairs into passion. Wren becomes pregnant and Cooper is determined to keep his heir, as well as Wren.

Afanasyev, Alexander - *Tales from Russian Folklore* – A new translation of Alexander Afanasyev’s collection of classic Russian folklore. Collection includes the stories of Baba-Yaga, Ivan the Fool, and Vasilisa and the Firebird.

Blanchard, Alice - *The Wicked Hour* –mystery- (Book 2 in the Natalie Lockhart series) The day after Halloween, Detective Natalie Lockhart finds the corpse of an unknown woman in a dumpster. Both women dream of opening and running a dress shop, but the heartbreak of Millie’s past is catching up to them.

Cleland, Jane K. - *Hidden Treasure*-cozy mystery- (Book 13 in the Josie Prescott Antiques mystery series) – Josie Prescott and her husband have finally purchased their dream home: a beach side Victorian home known as the “Gingerbread House.” However a mysterious trunk in the dumbwaiter, a missing widow, and a murder put Josie’s renovation plans on hold.

Clipston, Amy -*The Coffee Corner*-inspirational- (Book 3 in the Amish Marketplace series) – Micah Zook and his grandfather, Enos, visit Bethany Gingerich’s busy little coffee shop in the Amish Marketplace every Saturday. Bethany enjoys talking them, even if she is too shy to admit to herself how handsome she finds Micah. However, when tragedy strikes Micah one Saturday, Bethany learns she may just be the type of friend that he needs.

Cole, Alyssa -*How to Catch a Queen*-romance- (Book 1 in the Runaway Royals series)- Shanti Mohapi weds the King of Njaza, King Sanyu. Even though they married out of duty, Sanyu and Shanti feel a powerful attraction to one another. However, the citizens of Njaza only see their new queen as an outsider, and the country remains in turmoil.

Cossette, Connilyn-*To Dwell Among Cedars*-inspirational- (Book 1 in the Covenant House series) – Eliora is a Philistine, whose family is tasked with guarding the Ark of the Covenant. Ronen is a Levite tasked with returning the Ark to Shiloh. As Eliora and Ronen are drawn to each other despite their differences, they find themselves caught up in a battle for the soul of Israel.

Faber, Michael –*D (A Tale of Two Worlds)*-fantasy- The letter “D” vanishes from language. It vanishes from conversations and street signs and soon the dentist and local Dalmatians are missing. Dhikilo finds herself summoned to the history teacher, Professor Dodderfield and his dog, Nelly Robinson, and her world gets stranger from there.

Ferrier, Ryan –*Narcos*-graphic novel-A collection of stories involving the tangled mess of Pablo Escobar’s international drug trade in the 90’s. Based on the hit Netflix show.

Fowler, Christopher-*Oranges and Lemons*-mystery- (Book 19 in the Bryant & May series) When an outspoken Speaker of the House of Commons is crushed to death by a mountain of citrus, it seems like the perfect case for the Peculiar Crimes Unit. However, one detective is hospitalized, one is missing, and the entire staff has been laid off.

Frear, Caz -*Shed No Tears*-mystery-(Book 3 in the Cat Kinsella series)- Detective Cat Kinsella her partner, Luigi Parnell, finally have found a murder victim's remains from an older case, supposedly finally tying up loose ends. However, as they dig deeper, discrepancies begin to pop up, raising troubling questions and bringing Cat and Luigi closer to danger.

When two gang members are arrested, the gang tells them to stay quiet and take the charges. The newest gang member, Little, is tasked with actually figuring out what happened to the drug dealer and the possibility of a police frame-up.

Goodkind, Terry -*Heart of Black Ice*-fantasy-(Book 4 in the Nicci Chronicles)- A new danger is forming along the coast: the Norukai. These barbarian raiders are amassing a fleet to launch a final war and bring destruction to the Old World.

Griffin, W. E. B. -*The Attack*-thriller-(Book 14 in the Badge of Honor series)-When a sixteen-year-old cheerleader is found dead, Homicide Sergeant Matt Payne is relieved to find that the crime was caught by her parents' security cameras. However, on closer look, the footage is a little too perfect and the prime suspect may not be guilty after all.

Windemere wants Hawthorne to complete one last assignment and the reward is one he can't resist: the hand of Messalina Greycourt.

Jennings, Regina -*Courting Misfortune*-inspirational-(Book 1 in the Joplin Chronicle series)-Calista York is sent to Joplin, Missouri, to complete her last case needed for her to finally become a Pinkerton operative. However, handsome missionary, Matthew Cook, keeps interfering with her investigation, endangering her disguise, her mission, and the girl she is trying to protect.

Kepler, Lars -*Lazarus*-mystery-(Book 7 in the Detective Inspector Joona Linna series)- A brutal killer is murdering Europe's most notorious criminals and all clues are pointing to someone from Joona Linna's past.

Klassen, Julie -*A Castaway in Cornwall*-inspirational-When a man washes ashore, Laura Callaway rescues and cares for him. Laura often feels alone and outcast, and finds herself drawn to the mysterious stranger. Yet not everything is at it seems with her handsome guest.

Lackey, Mercedes -*Jolene*-fantasy-(Book 15 in the Elemental Masters series)-When Anna May Jones loses her father to the Black Lung, the coal company wastes no time turning the family out of their home. Anna May stays with her witchy Aunt Jinny and begins to settle into her new life. However, the man Anna May loves disappears and she finds herself on a quest to save him, armed only with the new skillset learned from Aunt Jinny.

Lindsay, Jeffrey P. -*Fool Me Twice*-mystery-(Book 2 in the Riley Wolfe series)-Master thief Riley Wolfe is coerced into an impossible job—stealing a Vatican fresco. If he fails, not only will Riley die, but the love of his life and, more importantly, master forger Monique, will be killed as well.

Malerman, Josh -*A House at the Bottom of a Lake*-horror-The author of *Bird Box* returns with another haunting tale—this one of summer love and a house at the bottom of the lake.

Miller, Sam J. -*The Blade Between*-horror-Ronan Szepessy once swore he would never return to Hudson, but circumstances forced his return. However, the once thriving industrial town is now brimming with enraged spirits and angry citizens, and chaos threatens to bubble over and engulf everything and everyone Ronan cares for.

Perry, Thomas -*Eddie's Boy*-mystery-(Book 4 in the Butcher's Boy series)-Michael Shaeffer is forced to flee England when the mafia tries to kill him. While trying to get out of his current predicament, Michael flashes back to training to become the Butcher's Boy, and is forced to reflect on how his past is destroying his future.

Poyer, David -*Violent Peace*-thriller-(Book 20 in the Dan Lenson series)-World War III is over, but instead of peace, there is a power vacuum the remaining super powers are trying to fill. Is the end of the war merely a stepping stone for the start of a new war?

Rozan, S. J. -*The Art of Violence*-mystery-(Book 20 in the Bill Smith, Lydia Chin series)- A former client comes to Bill Smith and Lydia Chin with a bizarre request: he's positive he's killed two women, but he has no recollection of the murders. He wants to enlist Smith and Chin to help him find the truth.

Shelton, Paige -*Cold Wind*-mystery-(Book 2 in the Alaska Wild Mysteries series)- The man who kidnapped Beth Rivers is still at large in St. Louis, so she is remaining in Alaska. However, when a mudslide unearths a trapper's cabin as well as a woman's dead body, Beth feels pulled to investigate.

Smiley, Jane- *Perestroika in Paris*-literary-Paras is a curious Parisian racehorse who escapes from her stable to explore the City of Light. She soon befriends Frida, a German shorthaired pointer, as well as the human boy, Etienne. But as Christmas nears, how long can a racehorse longing for love and freedom, stay hidden in Paris?

Tillyard, Stella -*Call upon the Water*-literary-Jan Brunt arrives in Great Britain in 1649 to work on developing marshy wetlands in a project known as the Great Level. He meets and falls in love with Eliza, but circumstance and their differences force them apart. Jan flees to America to work for profiteers, but his past—including Eliza—follow him to the New World.

Tolsma, Liz -*The Gold Digger*-inspirational- (Book 9 in the True Colors series)-In 1907, Ingrid Storset travels to stay with her widowed sister, Belle. However, she is confused by Belle setting up interviews for new husbands, especially considering she's already lost two. When a stranger comes to town, looking for a brother who was supposed to marry Belle, Ingrid must confront the truth about her sister.

Tope, Rebecca -*A Cotswold Christmas Mystery*-cozy mystery-(Book 18 in the Thea Osborne series)- It's Christmas time and Thea's daughter is coming to visit! But when the mother of a local family goes missing, and the family itself has been in a long dispute with the landlord, Thea finds herself being pulled into a mystery.

Tsao, Tiffany -*The Majesties*-mystery-Gwendolyn and Estella were supposedly the closest that sisters could be, but Gwendolyn is soon in a coma, fighting for her life after Estella poisoned the entire family. As Gwendolyn claws her way to consciousness, she is forced to remember the deceptions, betrayals, and family secrets that may have driven Estella to her murderous act.

Tursten, Helene –*Snowdrift-mystery*-(Book 3 in the Detective Inspector Embla Nystrom series)-Before Detective Inspector Embla Nystrom can fully process receiving a phone-call from her friend that has been missing for over fourteen years, she is called to investigate a murder scene. However, Embla is shocked to discover that the victim has ties to her long lost friend.

Tyce, Harriet -*The Lies You Told-mystery*-Sadie Roper is starting over as a barrister after a ten year absence. However, her ex is still harassing her, she has no friends, and her kids hate their new school. Life finally seems to be turning around when she meets Liza, but Liza holds secrets of her own.

Woods, Stuart -*Hush-hush-mystery*-(Book 4 in the Harriet Blue series)- Harriet Blue has fallen from detective to inmate 3329. What's worse, the man who put her into prison is now offering her freedom if Harriet can find his missing children.

Yu, E. Lily -*On Fragile Waves* –*fantasy*-Firuzeh and Nour are refugees from Afghanistan, en route to the sanctuary of Australia. To help cope with the terrors of the journey—temporary shelters, mercenaries, and vanishing friends—the family spins fairy tales about the opportunities awaiting them in their new home.
